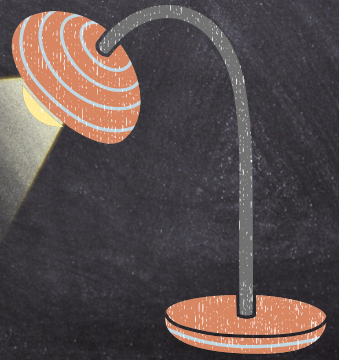
FRUIT SALAD ACTIVITY

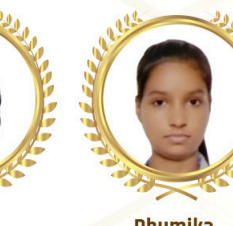

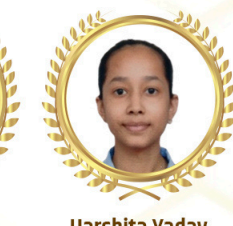

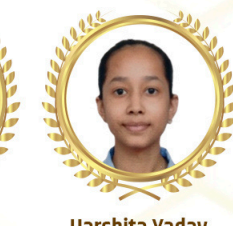
